OVERVIEW

[Last updated: KB – 5 Sept 2019]

At KS4 pupils will study Religious Education as part of their GCSE Citizenship curriculum programme. Each year will involve content which is directly linked to their GCSE content and mapped into the citizenship SOL. Alongside this they will be delivered discrete lessons where the required content does not link with the GCSE SOL.

TOPICS COVERED:

YEAR 9: HUMAN RIGHTS
CHRISTIANITY (BELIEFS AND PRACTICES)
YEAR 10: GOOD and EVIL
JUDAISM (BELIEFS AND PRACTICES)
YEAR 11: LIFE AND DEATH

STRUCTURE	
LESSONS	2 lessons a fortnight [60 minutes each].
CLASS WORK	Where appropriate and mapped to the Citizenship SOL the work will be completed in their Citizenship exercise books. Where they are discrete units of work they will be completed in their RE (yellow) books or booklets depending on the lesson material. <i>Gwaith Dosbarth</i> and the date in Welsh should be written down in all lessons (where applicable).
DELIVERY	Each year will introduce the unit either within the citizenship lesson or the discrete lessons. Each lesson will deliver the content and build towards an Exam practice question/ Extended writing task / DIRT.
ASSESSMENT & FEEDBACK	Assessments will cover skills/requirements of the specification where integrated into the Citizenship SOL. Year 9: 3x assessments –Theme A Human Rights. Year 10: 3x Assessments – Theme C Good and Evil Year 11: 3x Assessments – Theme D. Life and Death
SKILLS	National Curriculum skills for RE will be highlighted in the Citizenship SOL and the Discrete SOL for the topics which will run alongside the GCSE.
HOMEWORK	Homework will be integrated into lessons and signposted in the short-term planning.
