Dear Parents and Carers,

As the local and national coronavirus situation continues to improve, we will be making some changes for pupils in Years 7 to 11.

As from Monday, the 26th of April, the following changes will be made;

- During the winter months, pupils were permitted to wear coats in class, as windows are left open for ventilation. However, with the onset of the warmer weather, pupils will no longer be permitted to wear coats or any non-uniform items in class.
- Whilst reviewing PE arrangements over the coming week, PE kit must no longer be worn to school. PE will take place and further details will follow regarding PE kit, pending review of the risk assessment.
- Only BTEC pupils in Years 9, 10 and 11, should bring their PE kit in to school with them to change into for lessons this coming week.
- Please be aware that should any pupil attend school in the incorrect uniform, that they may be required to return home and change, before they are admitted to school.
- No piercings of any kind are allowed to be worn in PE lessons. Should any pupil arrive to PE with a piercing, they will not be allowed to participate in the lesson until the piercing is removed.
